Larry Busdeker Named Distinguished Volunteer

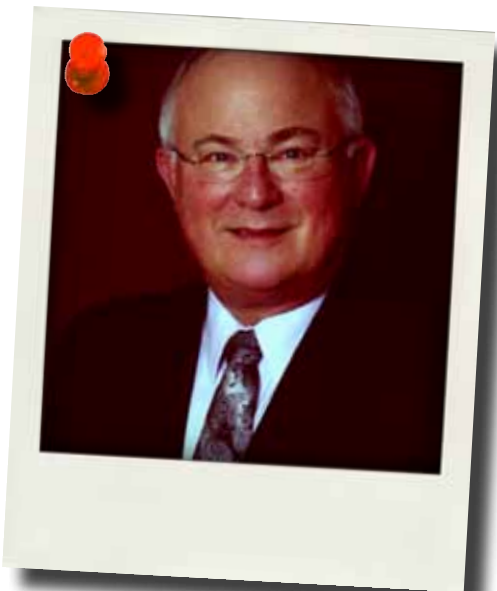
Larry Busdeker, superintendent of Hancock County schools, has been selected to receive this year's Distinguished Volunteer Award.

Busdeker was nominated by Rick Van Mooy, coordinator for the Hancock County Educational Service Center, for his commitment to the community and his extensive volunteer experience with many non-profit organizations. Busdeker is a member of the Camp Fire USA Northwest Ohio board and has been since 2006. He currently serves as vice president. A letter in support of his nomination stated that "he is constantly looking for ways that Camp Fire USA can be involved in the community."

Busdeker also serves on numerous boards and committees including; Boy Scouts of America Black Swamp Area Council; Challenged Champions Equestrian Center, Inc.; Hancock County School Insurance Consortium; Northwest Ohio Educational Technology Foundation; Hancock County Family & Children First Council; Hancock County CrimeStoppers; Reducing Risks in Educational Settings Task Force; 2-1-1 Steering Committee; Workforce Investment Act Policy board; Help Me Grow; Findlay Hancock County Chamber of Commerce board (now known as GreaterFindlayInc.); and the Hancock County Assets Team. He is a member of Findlay Noon Rotary where he served as president in 2007-2008.

His volunteer work with United Way of Hancock County has been extensive. He served as the education division chair in 1984 and the rural division chair in 1998. He completed 2 three-year terms on the United Way of Hancock County board and was the board president in 2003. He was a team captain under the rural division in 2007.

Another recommendation letter indicated that Busdeker has made significant contributions in Hancock County through community involvement and leadership positions. Busdeker is an individual who takes initiative and finds ways to improve the community.



Cole Lautermilch Selected as Secor Scholar

United Way of Hancock County's Secor scholarship committee has selected Cole Lautermilch, a senior at Findlay High School, as this year's United Way Foundation Secor Scholar. The \$2,000 renewable Secor Scholarship was established as a memorial to the Steven and Doris Secor bequest. It is awarded to a high school senior or high school graduate living in Findlay or Hancock County who plans to attend an accredited institution of higher learning to pursue any undergraduate field of study, full time in the subsequent academic year. The candidate must exhibit a strong commitment to academic studies as well as volunteer and extracurricular involvement.

Lautermilch, the son of Tim and Barb Lautermilch, was selected because of his volunteer experience and leadership. He is described as a person who educates his peers, motivates people and makes positive change happen.

"Cole is the kind of citizen who doesn't wait to be asked what he can do," said Kimberly Bash, program officer, The Community Foundation. "His style of servant leadership is contagious."

Some of Lautermilch's volunteer work includes serving on the Emerging Community Leaders Investing in Philanthropic Service (ECLIPSe) grant-making council and the Mayor's Teen Advisory Council. He is also a member of Junior Statesman of America (JSA) and is president of that organization at Findlay High School. Through his work with JSA, Lautermilch has helped educate students and adults about the needs in Tanga, Tanzania. He has helped raise money to purchase bed nets to fight malaria, build two water wells, help build a school, provide farm implements and provide finances for an orphanage. He has obtained the rank of Eagle Scout, is president of the Findlay High School National Honor Society and serves on the youth leadership board at Findlay Saint Michael's Parish. He intends to study international relations or political science.

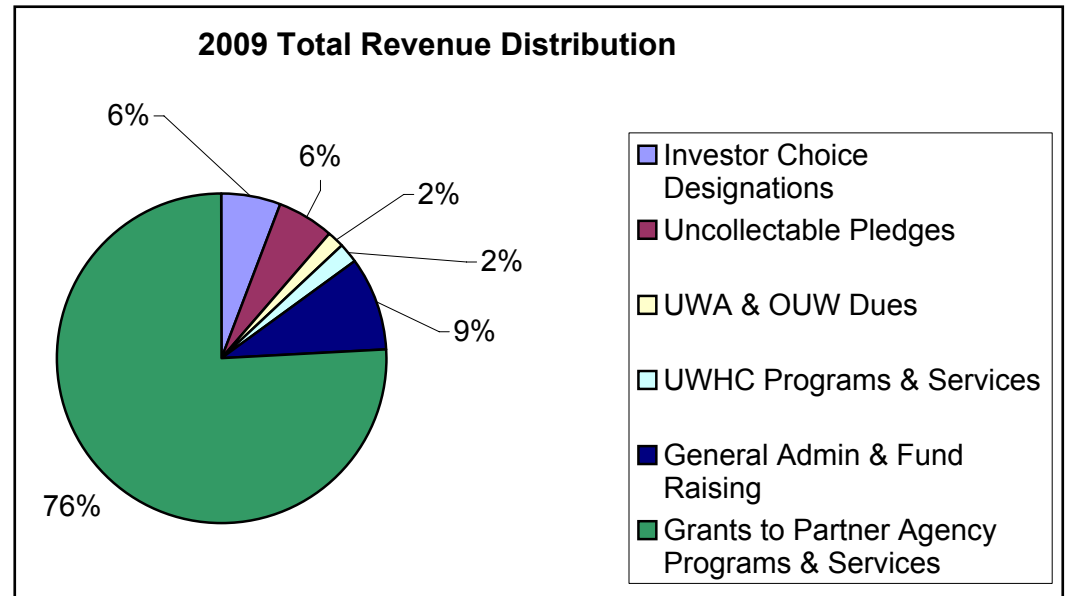
Financial Statement

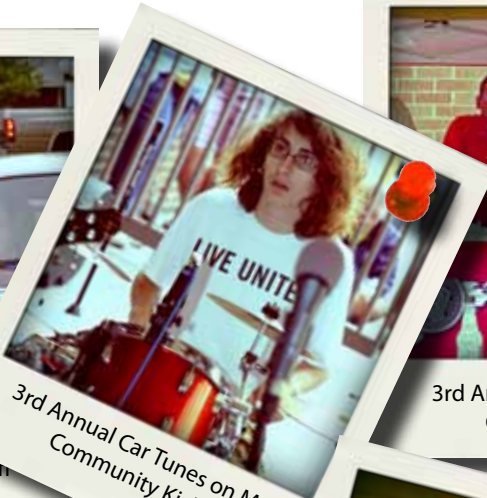

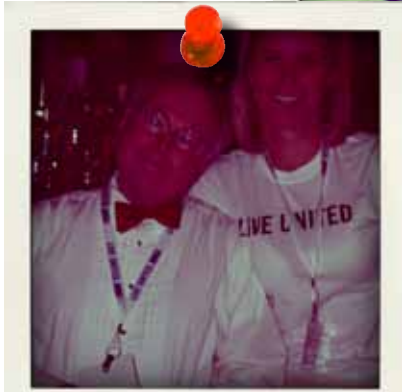

Hope House Shelter: provides safe, decent, affordable housing to bridge the gap between emergency shelter and permanent housing for women and single men with children

Girl Scouts of Western Ohio

Personal and Leadership Development: promotes girls' personal growth and leadership development through a coordinated, progressive series of activities and experiences that help them become socially, morally, emotionally, physically and cognitively competent.

Hancock County Voices for Children/CASA: recruits, trains and supports volunteer Court Appointed Special Advocates as they represent abused, neglected or dependent children in the courts

HHWP Community Action Commission

Individual Development Account: helps people save for home ownership, education or a business start up or expansion

Hancock Area Transportation Services (HATS): a public transportation program taking people to work, health appointments and more

Ohio Benefit Bank: provides low to moderate income families with various federal benefit programs including tax preparation and foreclosure mitigation counseling

Northwest Ohio Kidney Foundation

Providing Resources and Opportunities to Maximize Independence through Service Endeavors (PROMISE): helps people with kidney disease by providing education, support, advocating patients' rights, and promoting organ and tissue donation

Open Arms Domestic Violence & Rape Crisis Services

Adult Services: provides immediate shelter for persons fleeing from violence

Child Services: screening for abuse, conducting support groups for children, and providing supervised visits
